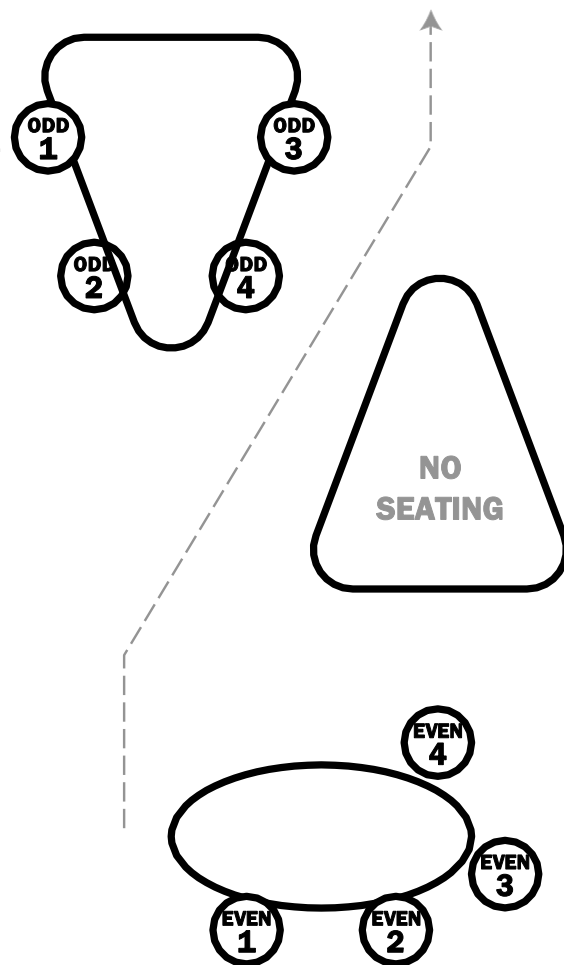
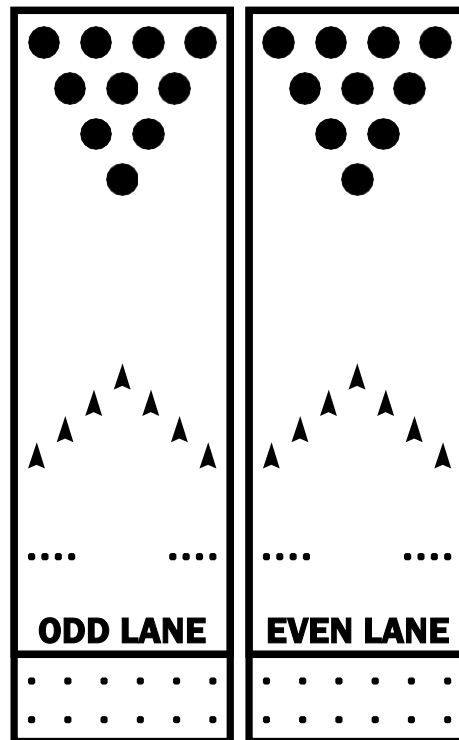


LEAGUE RULES FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING

1. The team that is scheduled to bowl on the odd lane will be assigned to the bowler's seating area. The team that is scheduled on the even lane will be assigned to the concourse seating area. See diagram on right.
2. To limit the number of people in the bowlers' area, **spectators will not be allowed.**
3. The center has adopted a bowling format to provide social distancing and safe play. Teams will be bowling PBA style. To start the game, the team with the arrows pointing to the odd lane will bowl their first frame while the other team sits. Once they complete their first frame, the other team will then bowl two frames. Each team will then bowl two frames at a time for the duration of the game.
4. Each bowler should self-monitor for any symptoms of illness. A league bowler **should not come to the center** if they are actively experiencing any of the following symptoms: Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell. It is also recommended that any affected league bowler seek the advice of a licensed health care professional.
5. We have taken enhanced health and safety measures. Bowlers must follow all safety instructions while at the center. **An Inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present.** COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, certain persons with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.
